Dear Mr. Rockwell:

It was a pleasure having you as a key member of our project team, which proved invaluable in our pursuit of LEED Operations & Maintenance credentialing process, and ultimately to project certification which has been awarded on 10-22-10.

Our situation is not typical as we are a 1.6 million square foot facility that has gone through 5 major expansions in as many decades. The electrical and mechanical systems have been designed by different engineers over diverse technological periods.

The nature of our business also makes any approach to LEED waste management credits equally unique. Mr. Rockwell's job was to audit our current practices, see where we were complying with LEED standards, determine where we could improve, and finally come up with a description of our methods that described them accurately, and showed how they meet the requirements of LEED.

He was assigned and directly responsible for providing the systems, education plans, policies, and documentation for MR Prerequisite 2, Solid Waste Management, and Credits MR7, Solid Waste Management – Ongoing Consumables and MR8, Solid Waste Management – Durable Goods. He was involved with the project from August 2009 to the date of submission of the project, June 17, 2010

He couldn't have done it without a great deal of understanding about waste management in general, and LEED criteria specifically. I would recommend Mr. Rockwell for any LEED project as ours was uniquely difficult, yet he did a fantastic job.
